I left the course feeling embarrassed, disengaged, and with little to show for it. That experience sparked an idea: to create a learning environment that was engaging, enjoyable, and delivered by professionals with real-world experience.

By 2010, Meditec Training Ltd was founded, with the vision of revolutionizing first aid education. Our mission was, and still is, to provide life-saving skills in a friendly, supportive, and interactive way—delivered by instructors who bring extensive hands-on experience and passion to every course.

Over the past decade, we have trained countless individuals and received incredible feedback from learners and clients alike.
